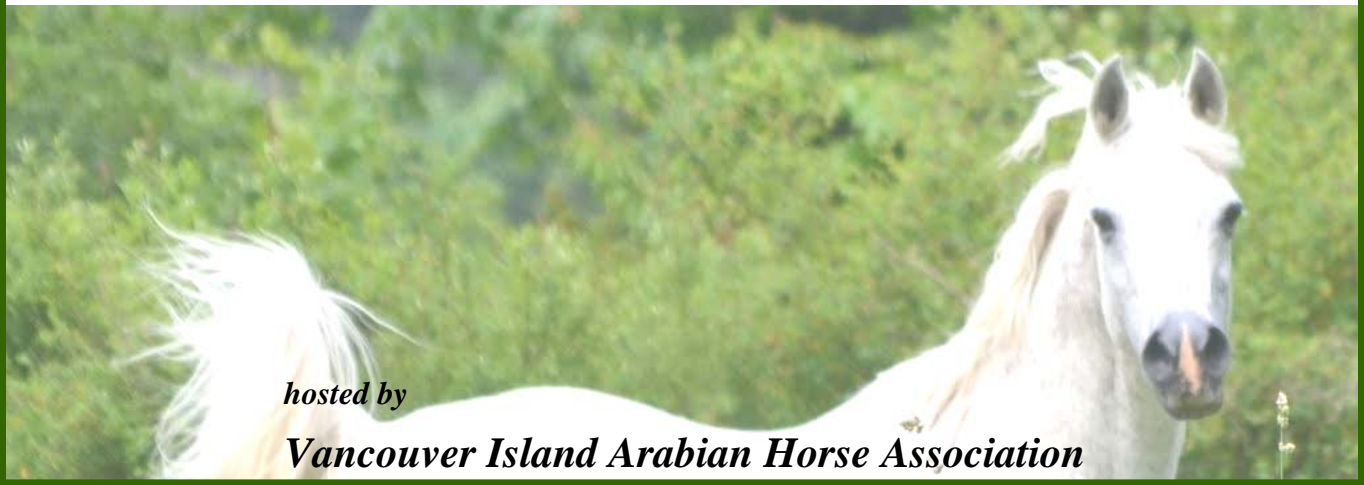

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### AHA MEMBERSHIP STATEMENT

EACH COMPETITOR (THIS INCLUDES AT LEAST ONE RECORDED OWNER AND ALL TRAINERS, DRIVERS, RIDERS, HALTER HANDLERS, COACHES AND THE PERSON(S) SIGNING THE ENTRY BLANK) IN AN ARABIAN HORSE ASSOCIATION RECOGNIZED ARABIAN DIVISION, AT THE TIME OF ENTRY INTO A COMPETITION, MUST SUBMIT A COPY OF A VALID AHA MEMBERSHIP/COMPETITION CARD, JOIN AHA OR PAY AN AHA SINGLE EVENT MEMBERSHIP FEE PER COMPETITOR.

WHEN AN AGENT SIGNS FOR THE OWNER AT AN AHA RECOGNIZED COMPETITION, BOTH THE OWNER AND AGENT MUST BE MEMBERS OF AHA OR PAY THE AHA SINGLE EVENT MEMBERSHIP.

SINGLE EVENT MEMBERSHIP IS NOT ACCEPTABLE AT AHA REGIONAL OR NATIONAL COMPETITIONS.

EXHIBITORS IN WALK-TROT CLASSES ARE EXEMPT FROM AHA MEMBERSHIP REQUIREMENTS AT QUALIFYING COMPETITIONS, BUT MUST HAVE AN AHA MEMBERSHIP WITH COMPETITION CARD AT AHA REGIONAL AND NATIONAL COMPETITIONS.

EXHIBITORS IN LEAD LINE CLASSES OR PARENTS/GUARDIANS SIGNING FOR MINORS ARE EXEMPT FROM AHA MEMBERSHIP REQUIREMENTS. (BOD 5/12)

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## SHOW RULES

**No smoking is permitted in the barns or areas with hog-fuel or shavings under foot.**

**Dogs must be on a Leash at all times – No exceptions.**

### **Entry Forms:**

The Show Committee reserves the rights to refuse any entry, and to combine or split classes if entries warrant, and also to cancel classes if there are not at least two entries for the class. A class will be split only if it results in at least 4 entries in each subsequent class. Full refund will be made for any class cancelled by the Show Committee.

Photocopies of registration papers, AHA Competition Level Membership card and HCBC membership card of the current year **MUST** be enclosed with entries. NO NUMBERS WILL BE ISSUED UNTIL THESE CARDS ARE PRESENTED TO THE SHOW SECRETARY. Exhibitors without a competition card must purchase an AHA Single Event membership (\$35 + \$10.50).

All horses **MUST** be registered with CAHR, AHRA, AHA or CPAR for Arabian/Half-Arabian & Anglo-Arabian Classes.

Entry forms must be signed by the **Trainer**: the Trainer is the person on the show grounds who is accepting responsibility for the entry.

Refunds of entry fees or stabling fees will not be made after the closing date of entries, except with a veterinary or doctor certificate stating that the horse/rider will be unable to show.

### **ADDITIONAL (TBA) CLASSES:**

The Additional TBA classes with the most entries will be selected to run in the TBA time slots; otherwise, first come, first served! TBA Class can be any class on the AHA Class List or that is recognized by AHA with the exception of Jumping, Working Hunter, Hunter Hack, Cutting, Reining Horse, Working Cow Horse or any Carriage Driving Class.

### **Dressage Times:**

Times for Dressage rides will be posted on club website [www.viarabianhorse.com](http://www.viarabianhorse.com) and on club facebook page by Thursday evening, June 9<sup>th</sup> 2022.

### **Gate Holds**

Gate Holds and Barn Calls are a courtesy only. It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to be on time for the class. Gate Holds will be permitted when requested before the class previous, and may be restricted to 2 minutes at the Show Committees' discretion.

### **Protective Headgear:**

All Dressage riders, regardless of age, must wear ASTM/SEI or BSI/BS EN approved protective headgear at all times when mounted at the show grounds during the Dressage Division.

Protective headgear may be worn without penalty by exhibitors in any section of the Arabian Division. All Junior riders must wear proper fitting, ASTM/SEI or BSI/BS EN approved protective headgear, with the safety harness correctly secured, at all times while mounted on the show grounds. However, the rules for appointments in divisions such as Saddle Seat and Western supersede this rule. It is highly recommended that protective head gear be worn until just before entering the show ring.

### **General Rules:**

1. All animals shall be subject to a Veterinary inspection, if such examination is deemed advisable. Horses shall be shown without artificial appliances, stimulants or sedatives.
2. AHA Value Shows only count toward AHA qualifications and programs
3. The Show Committee or Judge reserves the right to have any animal measured for toe length. Maximum 4 3/4 inch toe length for Purebred Arabians. Half-Arabian/Anglo-Arabians may have a 5 1/4 inch toe length. All horses artificially, improperly or unfairly prepared or tampered with before coming into the show arena will be disqualified. If it is ascertained that an exhibitor has made, or has caused to be made, any false statement in regard to any animal or exhibitor, or if any exhibitor shall attempt to interfere with the Judge in the performance of his duties, he or she will be excused from the competition.
4. No abuse of horses will be tolerated. Any animal with a visible whip mark or evidence of blood in the mouth or on the sides will be excused from the ring. Any person reported to show management as abusing a horse, anywhere on the show grounds, or causing a disturbance as to affect the conduct and safety of other horses, and/or exhibitors, and/or spectators, shall be liable for disciplinary action.
5. A Protest must be made in writing, addressed to the Show Secretary, and accompanied by a \$100.00 deposit in cash. It must be received within 48 hours of the Alleged Violation. All protests will be handled according to the Rules of the Equestrian Canada.

6. There will be no conferring with the Judge prior to or during the show. If anyone desires to meet with the Judge, this can be arranged through the Show Chairman.
7. Exhibitor numbers must be worn in the paddock or warm-up area prior to the class and in the show arena during competition. Failure to wear a competition number during the class may result in disqualification by the judge.
8. Refunds of entry fees or stabling fees will not be made after the closing date of entries, except with a veterinary or doctor certificate stating that the horse/rider will be unable to show
9. A substitution of a horse is allowed if the original entry cannot be shown and is scratched from the show. A fee of \$25.00 will be levied for a substitution, except in the case of equitation classes where no fee will be levied.
10. Hors concours is allowed but must pay required class entry fee for any class entered.
11. Horses may not arrive before **6:00 pm Saturday evening**. All horse trailer traffic must use Gate 6 from Stelly's Cross Road.
12. To enter a Championship Performance class a horse must show in another class for specific division.

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It is the responsibility of the show/event committee, or organizers and the facility owners and managers to ensure that all BC Health Authority, viaSport and WorkSafeBC directives are followed and enforced. Please follow all vaccination requirements as dictated by your regional Health Authority. Horse Council BC is not a regulatory body and it is understood and agreed that sanctioning and approval of either a HCBC Provincial circuit event or Equestrian Canada Bronze or Silver competition relates to the use of the rule book and approved officials only.

This Competition is a Horse Council BC provincially sanctioned Competition and will be governed in accordance with the Horse Council BC Rule Book. Knowledge of the Rules is the responsibility of the Competitor.

Neither Horse Council BC, its Board of Directors, organizing committee, staff, volunteers, officials, or employees of this horse show, will be responsible in any way, for damage, injury, or loss to persons, horses or property of exhibitors, spectators, owners, riders, trainers, or grooms. All competitors and owners of horses must be members of Horse Council BC to participate”

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## CLASS SPECIFICATIONS

Every class offered herein is covered by the Rules and Specifications of the current Rules of the Equestrian Canada and will be held and judged in accordance with the 2022 EC Rule Book.

### **Sport Horse In-Hand:**

Horses will be shown individually on the Triangle.

See EC Rule Book Section B Chapter 24 for ring procedure and class specifications.

### **Arabian Halter:**

Single Judge comparative system will be used.

### **Most Classic and Most Classic Head:**

Open to horses 2 years old and over. First Place only will be awarded. See Article B1405 and Article B1406.

Most Classic to be judged on type, presence, animation, carriage and conformation.

Most Classic Head to be judged against Breed Standards (Article B1301).

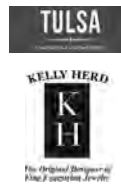

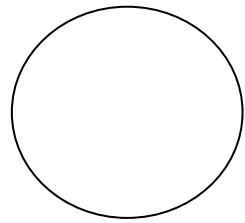

I have read the rules concerning competitions as printed in the Arabian Horse Association® (AHA®) Handbook and the Value Show Rules and agree to be bound by and subject to those Rules **and understand all decisions made by the judge are deemed final and can not be protested.**

**AHA ASSUMPTION OF RISK, RELEASE AND INDEMNIFICATION**

**This document waives very important legal rights. Read it carefully before signing.**

In consideration for AHA permitting me to participate in this Competition, and by signing the entry blank, I agree as follows:

**I AGREE** that I choose to participate voluntarily in this Competition, as a rider, driver, handler, leasee, owner, agent, coach, trainer, junior exhibitor, or as a parent or guardian of a junior exhibitor. **I AM FULLY AWARE AND ACKNOWLEDGE THAT HORSE SPORTS AND PARTICIPATION IN THIS COMPETITION INVOLVE SERIOUS RISK OF HARM INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO, RISKS OF ACCIDENT, SERIOUS BODILY INJURY, INCLUDING DEATH, BROKEN BONES, HEAD INJURIES, TRAUMA, PAIN AND SUFFERING, AND PROPERTY DAMAGE. I ASSUME ALL RISKS OF HARM TO ME, MY HORSE OR MY PROPERTY.**

*I AGREE as a Horse Show Participant (or Parent/Guardian of Participant if a minor) to waive all claims which may otherwise arise from, including but not limited to infectious bacteria, viruses, fungi/mold, parasites or other agents which may be present at the Horse Show (and most other outdoor locations) and can cause infection in humans, as well as in animals.*

**I AGREE** that AHA has the sole right to control, sell, supervise or give away (or assign to others the right to do so) the exclusive rights to broadcast, televise, reproduce, transmit and disseminate all or part of this event, and I agree that AHA may use or assign, in any way AHA sees fit, photographs, films, videos, audios, cablecasts, or other likenesses of me and my horse taken during the course of the Competition for the promotion, coverage or benefit of the Competition or AHA. Those likenesses shall not be used to advertise a product and they may not be used in such a way which implies endorsement of any company, product, product category or service. I hereby expressly and irrevocably waive and release any rights in connection with such use, including any claim to compensation, invasion of privacy, right of publicity, or to misappropriation.

**I AGREE and represent** that I am qualified and eligible to enter and/or participate in the Competition and every horse I am entering is qualified and eligible as entered .

**I FUTHER AGREE** that by participating in an Amateur class that I am in compliance with the USEF Amateur rule.

**By signing below** as a parent or guardian of a junior exhibitor, I consent to the child's participation and agree to all of the above provisions, and further agree to assume all of the obligations of this AHA Assumption of Risk, Release and Indemnification personally and on behalf of the child.

**This AHA Assumption of Risk, Release and Indemnification** is governed by the Laws of the State of Colorado and is intended to be interpreted as broadly as possible. I agree that exclusive jurisdiction and venue (place) for any legal action against AHA, its officers, directors, employees, volunteers or agents shall be in the local district courts or the federal court of the State of Colorado. If any part of this agreement is determined to be unenforceable, all other parts shall remain in effect.

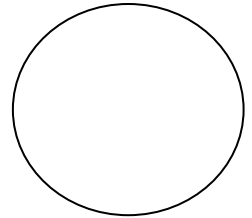
