

Vancouver Island Arabian Horse Association Annual All-Arabian Hi-Point Awards

**Categories: Junior Rider
Senior Amateur Rider**

Hi-Point Rules:

1. A Champion Hi-Point and Reserve Hi-Point will be awarded in each category, and presented at the annual VIAHA Awards Banquet.
2. Hi-Point riders must be a Senior or Junior member of the Vancouver Island Arabian Horse Association. .
3. These members will not have to submit results to be considered for the Hi-Point Awards. Points will be calculated by one of the VIAHA Directors.
4. Eligible Classes for Senior Amateur:
All Adult Amateur classes: ATR, AATR, AOTR, AAOTR and Select Rider classes
5. Eligible Classes for Junior Rider:
All Junior classes: ATR, JTR, JOTR, and Select Rider classes and including Equitation
6. Results for Showmanship &/or ATH halter classes may be used to break ties.
7. All of the Arabian Horse Association (AHA) recognized shows will count, including all Class A shows, Regional Championships, Western Canadian Breeders and the AHA National shows. Show season is generally from February to the end of October.
8. Points will be calculated only for the rider. The rider may ride more than one horse and is not required to own the horse. Purebred and Partbred Arabian results will be combined for each rider.
9. Point Calculation Formula:
Number of horses in the class minus your placing plus 1, times the Point Rate.
For example:
placing 2nd in a class of 12 results in *11 points* at a Class A show ([12 – 2 + 1] x 1), or *22 points* at the Regionals ([12 – 2 + 1] x 2).

Placings	1 to 6	Top 5	Top 6	Top 10

10. Points will be calculated for all eligible classes for the current calendar year. Only the official class results listed on the AHA website at <http://www.arabianhorses.org> will be used.
